Explore can't-miss shops and hangouts in key neighborhoods such as the <u>Gaslamp Quarter</u>, <u>Little Italy</u>, <u>North Park</u>, <u>Old Town</u>, and others, and <u>get around</u> via the extensive system of trolleys, light rail, trains, buses, and water taxis.

San Diego International Airport (SAN)

San Diego International Airport is the primary international airport serving San Diego and its surrounding metropolitan area. The airport is located just three miles northwest of downtown San Diego and is the busiest single-runway airport in the United States, with a relatively small footprint, covering 663 acres of land. Interestingly, it was the first federally certified airfield to serve all aircraft types, including seaplanes.
